N=1,001 adults (18+) nationwide

Fielded May 29 – June 1, 2009

Margin of sampling error: ± 3.1 percentage points

1. Do you personally know someone who has ever been addicted to alcohol or drugs?

2. If you or someone in your family needed treatment for alcohol or drug addiction, do you think you would be able to afford the costs of treatment?

3. How concerned are you that people who are addicted to alcohol or drugs may not be able to get the treatment they need because they lack insurance coverage, or can't afford it?
